



Eyegaze Demo Screening Questions

When you receive an inquiry about the Eyegaze Edge or a request to do a demonstration, you will want to ask questions ahead of time to prepare and pre-screen the individual for eyegaze use. Here are some questions you may want to ask:

- Tell me about the individual
- What is their age/situation (e.g., accident, ALS, CP, etc.)
- Where do they live?
 - At home?
 - Independent living?
 - Skilled nursing facility (SNF) or rehab facility?
 - In a hospital?
 - Are they on hospice?
- Do they have insurance/Medicare/Medicaid?
- How are they currently communicating?
- Are they working with a speech-language pathologist (SLP) or have they seen one recently?
- Tell me about their body movement and their seating arrangement?
- Can they answer yes/no questions by looking up and down?
- Are they able to look up, down, left and right? (you can send them a video example and ask for one in return to send to LC if unsure if they are a good candidate)
- Do you have an over-the-bed hospital rolling table, wooden table or kitchen counter I can mount the device on when I arrive?
- Who in the family or staff can I train on the device?

When you arrive:

- What would you like to do on your Eyegaze system?
- Will you use it in a bed, on a wheelchair, or out in the community?
